Good News! We have our lending library open! This is how it will work:

- Your child will choose a book on Monday
- Read the book with your child
- Each day focus on a set of questions that are written below
- Complete the reading log each day that you read to your child
- Complete the book report and send with the book on Friday
- Book should remain in your child's book bag ever day after reading.

Mon.-Before Reading Questions

- **Point to the book features ask:** Show me the front cover, back cover, spine. Where are the pages? What do you see on a page? Point to the pictures. Point to the words
- -Take a picture walk through the book without reading the words. Listen to the title and look at the picture. What do you think the book is about?
- -Who do you think the story will be about? Where are they in the story? (Look at the pictures and point out details that will help them answer) How do you think the characters are feeling? Why and how do you know that?

Tues-.During Reading Questions

- -Who are the characters? How are they feeling? Look at their faces to help you figure it out.
- -What do you think is going to happen next?
- -What is the problem in the story?
- -How does that make the characters feel?
- -What do you think happens next?
- -How will they solve the problem?
- -How do the characters feel at the end of the story?

Wed.- After Reading Questions

- Can you think of another way to solve the problem? (If they don't understand help them think of a different ending offer suggestions.)
- -Let's think of a different ending to the story
- -Who is your favorite character? Why? What part of the book did you like best? Why?

Thurs. Complete Book Report

-This can be a family affair be as creative as you like, but please make sure your child is helping with the project. Return report with the book on Friday. They will talk about their report in school on Mon.

Please take care of the book. It should be in your child's book bag every day. If it is lost you will be responsible for replacing the book. Have fun reading with your child it is one of the best activities you can do with them.
